Fall Greetings from the Preschool! The cooler weather is finally beginning and there are many changes in our environment this time of the year. ## **Halloween Festivities**

It's hard to believe that it's almost Halloween! Friday, October 31, is our Halloween Parade. The lower lot will be coned off for the safety of the children. All parents should park in the upper lot or near the playground and walk their child, dressed in costume, to the entry doors. Then, please grab a spot outside to watch the parade.

The parade will begin at 9:15 at the upper doors, and we will walk along the parking lot to the big rock. We will all sing a few holiday songs, and then there will be a photo op for each individual class. After the parade and photos are finished, the children will take off their costumes and have a regular school day. We will **NOT** have Friday Specials this day, so the kids can go home and rest up for the big night of Trick-or-Treat. Please see your teacher's emails or newsletters for specific party information. All treats that enter the preschool must be NUT-FREE.

Our 2 year old students do not parade outside the school. They will celebrate on Thursday, Oct 30, by wearing orange or a Halloween shirt and have a special snack during school. Please see your teacher's communications for further information.
